Dear Parents and Caregivers

I trust everyone is enjoying a well-deserved break with your families. Unfortunately, as Phase 5 of the COVID-19 recovery process has been delayed, I would like to emphasise that on-site operations for the beginning of Term 3 will remain the same as for Term 2.

- Hygiene protocols and cleaning procedures will continue until further notice.
- Parents and caregivers are asked not to enter classrooms and are reminded, if entering the school, to sign in at the front office.
- Morning and afternoon student pick up and drop off as follows...
 - In the morning, students to be dropped at the Camp Road 'Kiss and Go' carpark or George Street gates, then directed to classrooms by a staff member.
 - Gates will be unlocked at 8:15 am and locked at 8:40 am. If you arrive after 8:40 am, please call the front office and a staff member will assist you.
 - In the afternoon, **Pre-Kindergarten/Kindergarten** students will be dismissed at **2:50 pm**.
 - All other students (**PP to Year 6**) will be dismissed at **3:00 pm**.
 - Please note, if your Pre-Kindergarten/Kindergarten child has an older sibling, you will need to parallel park until your other child/ren are dismissed at 3:00 pm.
 - For the safety of your children and to ease traffic congestion, please **DO NOT** get out of your vehicle in the Kiss and Go section of the carpark. If you need to buckle your child/ren in, please parallel park.
- If you wish to touch base with teachers, please email and arrange a time for a telephone conversation.

Once again, I cannot express my gratitude to parents, caregivers, students, staff and the wider St Joseph's community for your incredible patience during this time. As I have said before, we are truly blessed to be part of such a supportive, considerate and friendly community. We are all looking forward to the start of Term 3 and seeing the students return, eager to learn.
